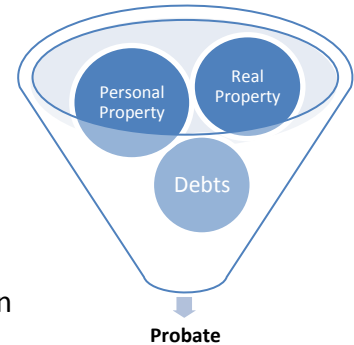


# Need Legal Help Due to a Death?

Riverside Legal Aid offers free assistance to qualifying low-income self-represented individuals who need assistance with probate issues relating to the death of an individual. Some examples include the following:

- Protections for the surviving family of the decedent
- Collecting the income or personal property of the decedent
- Transferring title (real property, vehicles, mobile homes)
- Dealing with creditors of the decedent
- Collecting a debt owed to you by a decedent
- Avoiding or minimizing disruption to public benefits caused by an inheritance
- Applying for an exemption or waiver of a Medi-Cal Lien
- Opening, administering, and closing a probate estate administration
- Contesting a will, or opposing a will contest
- Recovering misappropriated assets
- Unfunded Trusts
